The OT Reading and Gospel today mention those who were among the poorest in biblical times – the widows. The widow in the first reading has a son to support and yet she shared the last handful of meal and drop of olive oil with the prophet. Her generosity was rewarded by a never-ending supply of flour and oil. In the Gospel Jesus denounces the public display of the Scribes providing a background for an example of *genuine* religious behaviour on the part of a widow. She let go of every shred of security and committed herself wholly to God. The story is as much about *trust in God* as about generosity. On this special **Remembrance Day** we pray for the souls of all those who died in war and conflict and we put our trust in God that they, with our relatives and friends, who have gone before us, may enjoy the peace of the Heavenly Kingdom.

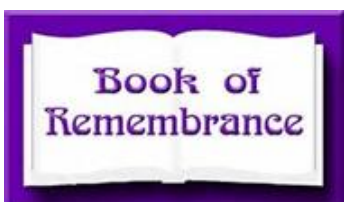
