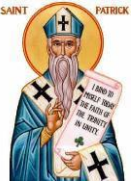

Authority – to Rule Over OR to Serve?

The action of the sons of Zebedee in today's Gospel indicates that they were seeking POWER. Jean Vanier (founder of L'Arche) distinguishes two kinds of authority – one which dominates and controls; and one which accompanies, listens, liberates, empowers, gives people confidence in themselves, and calls them to be aware of their responsibilities.

There is also a third kind of authority – silent, loving and hidden – the authority of powerless love, which waits, builds trust, and sometimes watches night and day in anguish. Parents have sometimes to wait and watch their children who have gone astray, hoping that they will come back. Jesus himself shows us the way to use authority – IN SERVICE to OTHERS.
