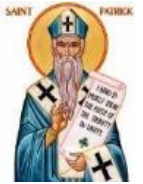

The Ministry of Consolation is having a break during August and will return on 10 September 2024 as usual.



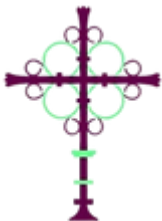
