

reMarkable

A short series of talks on St. Mark's Gospel by Fr. Tony Milner, STD, on Wednesday 10, 17 & 24 Jan at St. Theresa's, Old Shoreham Road, Southwick, 7:45pm. (Mass at 7pm, followed by refreshments.) This year on Sundays we will be hearing the Gospel of Mark. It the shortest and most dynamic of Gospels. It was probably written in Rome, for a small Church community that had known St. Peter, and was now enduring persecution and seeing people falling away. What was it like to hear the Gospel for the first time, possibly hidden secretly in a room in the city? The first session on 10 Jan will be a 'read through' of the whole gospel after a brief 'scene setting' to try to 'capture' its atmosphere. Then on 17 and 24 Jan we will look more closely at key features of Mark's story of Jesus.

Fr. Tony has taught Scripture at various places, including Wonersh and in Rome. He wrote his Licence thesis on the Gospel of Mark. He is Parish Priest of Our Lady Star of the Sea.
