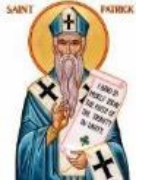

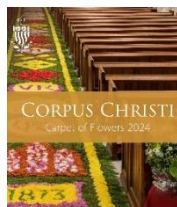
St. Patrick's Film Club: Thank you to all parishioners who came to the film evening. Watch out for the next one!
