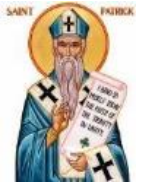

High Weald Walking Festival: Worth Estate, **Thursday 12 and Saturday 14 September.** Worth Abbey Pilgrims will be supporting the High Weald Festival again this year by offering a number of guided walks through the Worth Estate, celebrating the joy and beauty of Worth. The walks were incredibly popular last year and so this year they will offer 2 walks on Thursday 12 September, departing at 10.30am and 2pm promptly guided by Fr Patrick. These moderate-level walks will depart from the Abbey Church Piazza and will take approximately 1.5–2 hours depending on the group speed. The route is 4.6km and will include some muddy and uphill areas so sensible footwear is a must. Dogs on leads and children under 16 must be accompanied by an adult. They will also be offering a guided walk on Saturday 14 September from Balcombe Rail Station to Worth and return, departing promptly at 10.30am and returning at 4pm. This is a leisurely route over 7km and will include uphill and some stiles. This walk is not suitable for children or dogs. Bring a picnic to enjoy in the beautiful surroundings or enjoy refreshments which will be available to purchase on the Piazza at Worth Abbey. You are most warmly invited to join the Monastic Community at Worth in the Abbey Church for Midday Prayer at 1pm or Mass at 5.30pm on Thursday 12 or 5pm on Saturday 14 September.
