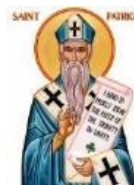

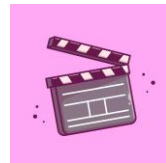


Harvest Supper: Normally Harvest time is a time to celebrate but our farmers
