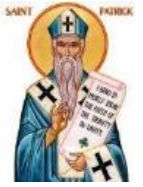

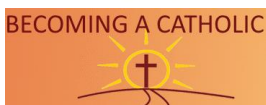

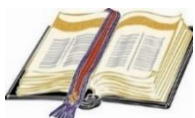
Blessing of the children and their school bookbags for the new school year: Can the children bring their school bookbags to Mass on **Sunday 10 September** for Fr. Max to bless.

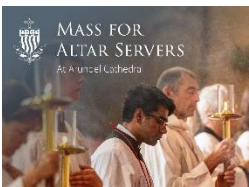
